Today, the school district was notified that four students were tested and confirmed positive for Covid-19.

One student from Building #3 was tested on Saturday, November 6th, and confirmed positive on, Monday, November 8th. The student was last in school on Thursday, November 4th.

Another student from Building #3 was tested on Sunday, November 7th, and confirmed positive on, Monday, November 8th. The student was last in school on Friday, November 5th.

One student from Building #4 was tested on Sunday, November 7th, and confirmed positive on, Monday, November 8th. The student was last in school on Friday, November 5th.

Finally, a student from Building #3 was tested this morning, Tuesday, November 9th, and confirmed positive. The student was last in school on Tuesday, November 9th.

According to Hellgate Elementary School Nurse, Mr. Brayden Byrne, all potential close contact individuals, both staff members and students, (students' parents), have been contacted. All notified individuals are working on safe and appropriate courses of action.
